3. Affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. Identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted.

Description : A stormwater outfall structure will be constructed along the south bank of the West Fork White River to provide storm water drainage located landward of the floodway. A 48" RCP outfall pipe will be buried to a depth of 4.8' in the floodplain. Approximately 8,000' of pipe will carry stormwater from the project area to the creek. The pipe will terminate with a 48" RCP end section that will conform to the bank slope. There is no need for a flapgate structure because all of the manholes will be above the 100 year floodplain elevation. An energy dissipator will be constructed at the base of the end section. The dissipator will consist of riprap. Approximately a 320' x 6' area will be filled in the south floodplain of the White River for the 2' minimum depth of cover requirement over a storm sewer pipe. The fill varies in depth from less than 1" on the landward side to approximately 2' on the streamward side. It will be set 185' back from the top of the bank and will have .78% slope. The finished elevation of the fill will be 922', NGVD. Vegetation will be placed on top of the completed fill. The fill material consists of spoil material remaining from storm sewer construction. Location : This project is intended to reduce flooding and improve stormwater drainage in an existing neighborhood in the Perdieu Road and Ewing Drive area in Muncie, Indiana. This main 48-inch pipeline crosses under S.R. 32/Kilgore Avenue and the railroad tracks just to the south.
