2. Be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. Affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. Identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted.

Description : The existing prestressed concrete adjacent box beam bridge carrying 13th Road over Yellow River will be replaced with a three-span prestressed concrete hybrid Bulb-T bridge. The new bridge will have span lengths of 89'-6", 90'-6" and 89'-6". The structure will have an out-to-out length of 280'-6.5" and a clear roadway width of 26'-0". The spill-through abutments will have 2:1 sideslopes armored with revetment riprap placed over a geotextile fabric. The abutments and piers will be skewed 55 degrees to align with the streamflow. The new approach roads will be raised above the existing approaches to allow for adequate freeboard beneath the bridge. The existing structure will be completely removed. Details of the project are contained in information and plans received at the Division of Water on July 13, 2009.

- Description : Approximately 115' of Eagle Creek's eroded stream bank will be stabilized. Eagle Creek has worn away a section of the northwest bank near an old bridge pier foundation. The utilized method for stabilization will be a high bank restoration technique, wherein revetment riprap will be keyed at the toe of the slope and placed to 6" below the OHWM and will be topped with 6" of compacted uniform riprap. Backfill will be placed on a geogrid over continuous geotextiles that will be laced continuously to the exterior netting of a vegetated coir log. A turf reinforcement mat over native vegetation seed will complete the 2:1 slopes. The banks will have a maximum height of 8.5' (matching the existing height) and a maximum streamward projection of 18.1' beyond the existing bank. The riprap, geotextiles, coir log, and other items will be from State approved sources. Elevations were based on the NAVD 88 vertical datum.
