2. Be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. Affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. Identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted.

Description : The existing steel sheet pile wall along approximately 1400' of the north (left) bank of the Lake George Canal is deteriorating and will be refaced with a new steel sheet pile wall to prevent bank failure. The existing wall will be left in place. The new wall will have the same alignment as the existing wall but will be 4'-0"± further out in the canal. Clean granular fill will be brought onsite to backfill the area between the old and new walls below the normal canal water line. Above the water line the gap will be filled with a slurry mix. The new steel sheet pile wall will be driven approximately 30' to 40' into the canal bed having a top elevation of 585.0' IGLD 1985 (approximately 30' to 35' above the canal bed). The new wall will be anchored using "tie-rods" anchored into the existing soil or bedrock. The anticipated spacing of the tie-rods will be between 8' and 15'. A waler will be placed across the face of the new wall to further stabilize the sheet piling. Two new "tie-back" steel sheet pile walls will be driven perpendicular to the new wall to connect the ends of the new wall to the ends of the existing wall at the east and west limits of the project site. Subsequent to the original construction of the existing sheet pile wall, an area of rock backfill (riprap) 300' long by 40' wide by 3' thick was placed along the wall between berths 1 and 2. Prior to driving the replacement sheet pile wall in this vicinity an eight (8) foot wide section of this rock backfill will be removed and spread on top of the remaining rock. Also along the remaining 1,100' of wall an eight wide by 1 foot deep section of the canal bed will be dragged to check for possible obstructions. Approximately thirty (30) temporary pipe pile "dolphins" will be driven into the canal approximately eight feet from the existing dock face to provide mooring for the working barges and to protect the new construction. These pilings will be removed after the replacement sheet pile wall has been constructed. Following construction of the new sheet pile wall, a concrete cap will be placed on top of the existing and new sheet pile and a new fender system installed along the wall. Oil booms will be placed in the canal during construction to minimize adverse impacts to water quality. The work is anticipated to begin May 1, 2011 and be completed around January 2012.
