



## GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 6, 2018 CALENDAR

### **TUESDAY, MAY 22, 2018: VOTER REGISTRATION OPENS**

**SATURDAY JUNE 30, 2018: DEADLINE**, by noon, for the Democratic or Republican Party to select a candidate to fill a vacancy on the general election ballot due to vacancy resulting from no candidate being nominated at a primary.

**DEADLINE**, by noon, for Libertarian Party to conduct a convention to nominate candidates or to take action to fill a ballot vacancy following a convention.

**MONDAY JULY 2, 2018: DEADLINE**, by noon, for independent or minor party candidate to file a petition of nomination with the county voter registration office for verification of petition signatures. (Starke County a candidate will need 113 valid signatures).

**TUESDAY JULY 3, 2018, DEADLINE**, by noon, for the Democratic or Republican Party to file a certificate of selection stating that a major party vacancy on the general election ballot resulting from a vacancy on the primary election ballot has been filled.

**DEADLINE**, by noon, to file a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate at the general election

**DEADLINE**, by noon, for libertarian party to file certificate of nomination for candidates' nomination for candidates nominated at the county convention or to certify a candidate selected to fill a vacancy following convention.

**MONDAY JULY 16, 2018, DEADLINE**, by noon, for a candidate nomination at the Primary Election, a candidate who has filled in a vacancy, or a write-in candidate, to voluntarily with-draw.

**DEADLINE**, by noon, for Democratic, Republican and Libertarian Parties to file a certificate of nomination of candidates nominated at the state party convention.

**DEADLINE**, by noon, for independent or minor party candidate to file a consent of candidacy and petition of nomination after verification of petition signatures.

**WEDNESDAY, JULY 25, 2018**, First day to file petition and consent for a school board office elected at the general election.

**FRIDAY, AUGUST 24, 2018, DEADLINE**, by noon, to file a petition and consent for school board office elected at the general election.

**SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2018, DEADLINE**, for county election board to mail absentee ballots to voters who have already filed an application for the general election with the circuit court clerk. To request an application please contact Voter Registration.

**TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2018: VOTER REGISTRATION ENDS** for a voter to register or transfer registration or at midnight for a voter to complete and submit a voter application online at

[www.indianavoters.in.gov](http://www.indianavoters.in.gov)

**WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2018:** First day a voter may vote absentee on the First Floor in the Starke County Court House.

**HOURS:** MONDAY-FRIDAY 8:00 AM to NOON and 1:00 pm to 4:00pm

**ADDITIONAL HOURS:** will be posted for evening and Saturday hours in October.

**THURSDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2018:** First day a confined voter, a voter caring for a confined person at a private residence, or a voter with disabilities may vote an absentee ballot before an absentee voter board at the voter's residence or place of confinement.

**FRIDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2018 DEADLINE**, by noon, for candidates to file pre-election campaign finance reports.

**MONDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2018: DEADLINE**, by 11:59 pm, for the county election, in the clerk's office to receive an absentee ballot application from an applicant requesting delivery of an absentee ballot by mail. Applications may be submitted to the county election in person or by mail, fax, or email. Deadline does not apply to voters entitled to vote by traveling board.

**MONDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2018: DEADLINE**, by noon. For county election, in the clerk's office to receive absentee ballot applications from confined person or voters caring for the confined requesting delivery of a ballot by an absentee voter board.

**DEADLINE:** by noon, for county election, in the clerk's office to receive absentee ballot applications from military/ overseas voters requesting vote by email or fax.

**DEADLINE:** by noon, for a voter to vote an absentee ballot in person on the first floor in the Starke County Court House.

**DEADLINE:** for a confined voter, a voter caring for a confined person, or a voter with disabilities to vote an absentee voter board at the voter's place of confinement.

**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2018 DEADLINE,** by noon, for a candidate to file a verified recount or contest petition.
